## Transparency and inclusivity

It is good to see FF's web page on the Framsden web site giving an outline of FF's work, the Chairman's annual report, minutes of FF's AGM, the income and expenditure account for 2017 and comments from a member of the community.

With regards to the income and expenditure sheet (2017) could FF consider adding/providing further details under Income (£367.93), Expenditure – Donations (£535.51) e.g. recipients and Other (£545.00).
